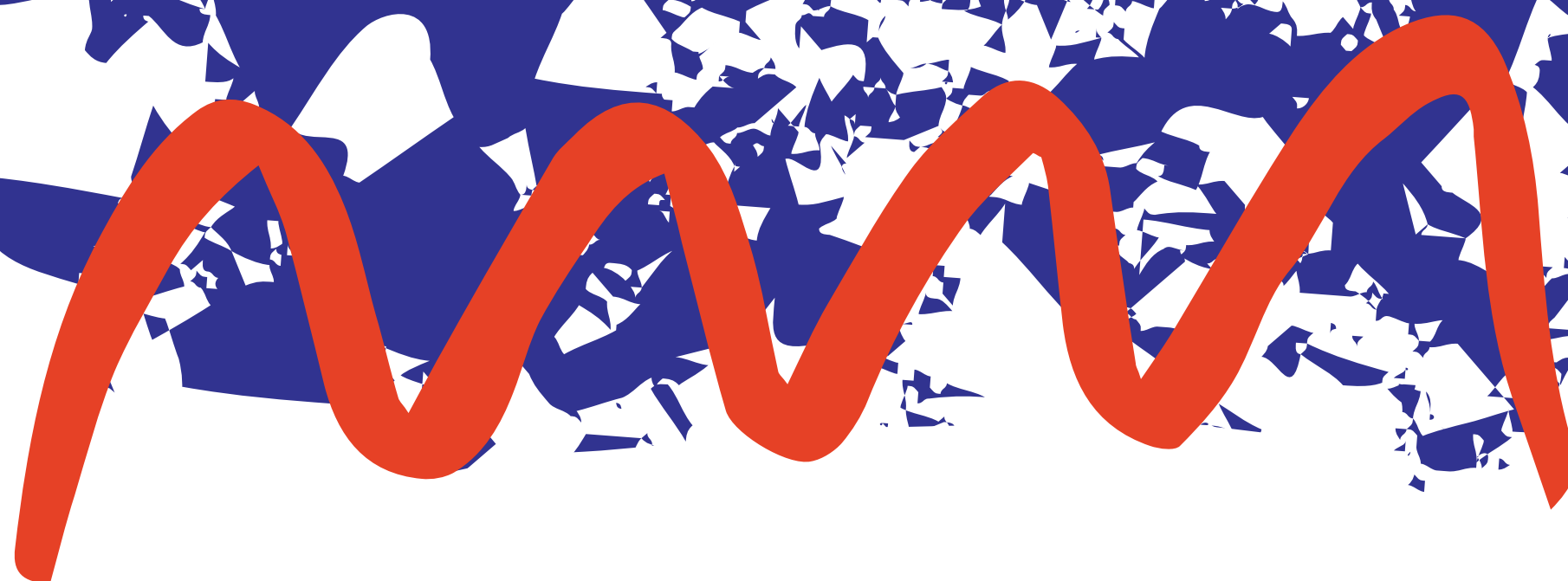


ENDANGERED SPECIES TASTER SESSION

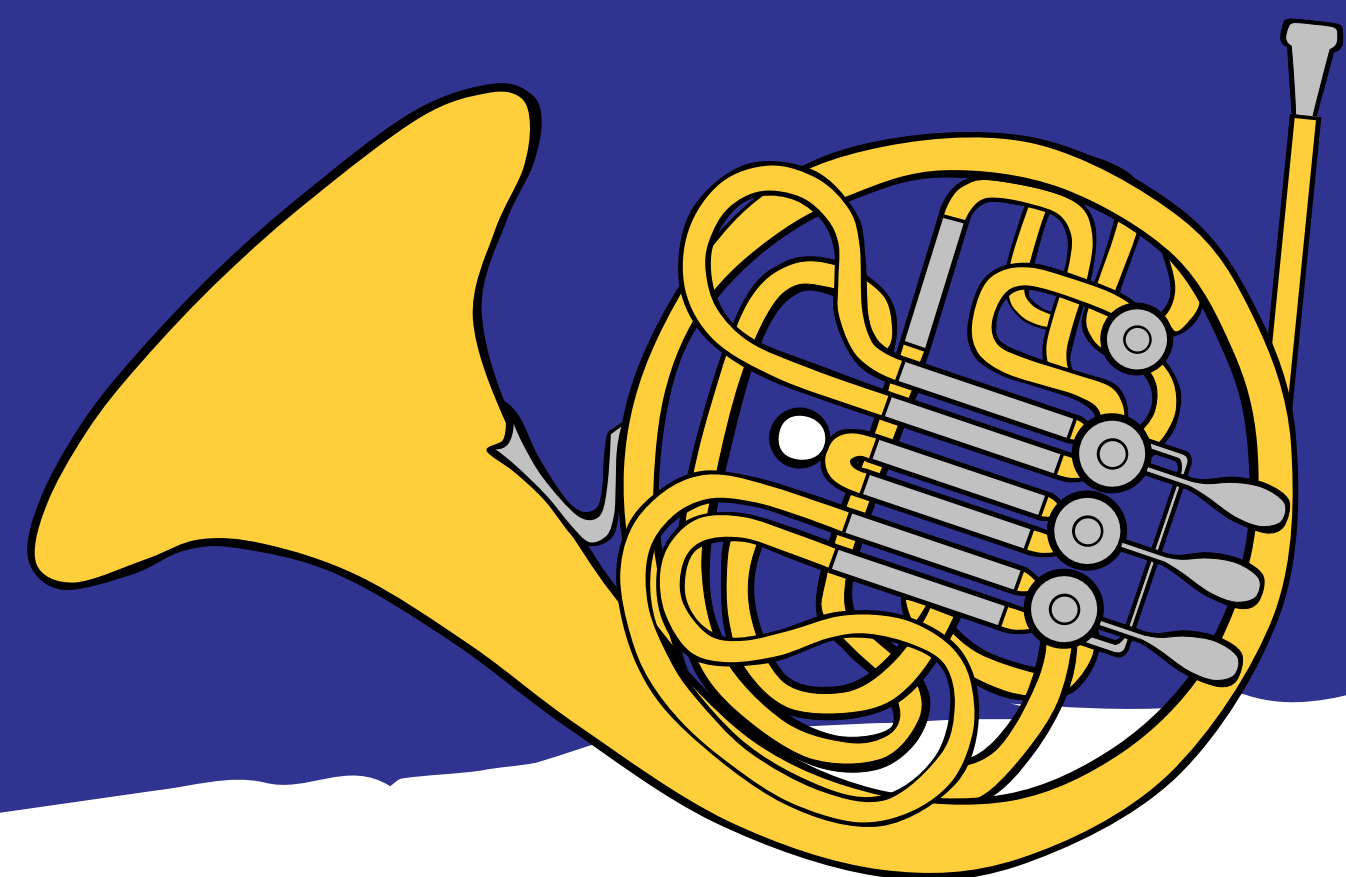
For Students in Year 3 - Year 6

Come along with your child to meet the endangered instruments. There will be a short demonstration on the Bassoon, Double Bass, French Horn and Oboe, followed by an opportunity to have a go! We will advise your child on the suitability of the instruments but we have both full size and mini instruments available.

The Endangered Species Centre was set up in 2004 to promote the playing of minority instruments, widen access to them and give the students a chance of learning these fascinating instruments in a group setting. Students learn together until the end of the school year when they have an opportunity of continuing in tuition as appropriate with
